

Please refer to the map and description below for proper protocol.



RED - NO PARKING

THE GRAVEL LOT IS CLOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION DR MAULT HAS REQUESTED WE NOT USE HIS LOT PLEASE DO NOT PULL UP BEHIND THE BUSES.

GREEN - IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE THE BUSES PLEASE USE THIS AREA.
THIS AREA WILL BE BLOCKED ONCE BUSES ARRIVE.
ABSOLUTELY NO MOVEMENT WILL BE ALLOWED.

ORANGE - USE CAUTION

IN THE MORNINGS PLEASE USE CAUTION AND FOLLOW THE ARROWS AS SHOWN. YOU MAY PARK ALONG THE OUTSIDE AREA OR DROP YOUR CHILD AT THE SIDEWALK NEAREST THEIR BUS AND PROCEED TO LEAVE.

IN THE AFTERNOON IF YOU ARRIVE LATE PLEASE USE CAUTION AND ENTER THE PARKING LOT FOLLOWING THE ARROWS AS THEY ARE SHOWN ALLOWING ENOUGH SPACE FOR OTHER VEHICLES THAT MAY ALSO ARRIVE LATE. BUS 3 WILL BLOCK THE REAR ENTRANCE TO THE PARKING LOT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL BOTH BUSES DEPART.
